Artis L. Spivey, Sr., 94, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Saturday, January 23, 2021.

Artis was born to Ollie and Willie Lawson Spivey, February 28, 1926, in Vienna, Louisiana and attended the public-school system in Alexandria, Louisiana. He entered the United States Army in December 1945, where he served and was awarded the WWII Victory Medal. After the military, Artis moved to Winnfield, Louisiana, where he worked at a saw-mill company for quite some time and eventually relocated to Topeka, Kansas, where he worked as a brick mason for Jayhawk Masonry for many years. It has been said that Artis was one of the best brick layers Topeka has ever known. Artis was just an all-around hard worker and a man of many talents. He was always helping senior citizens with fixing up their home and was also known to work on cars. Artis was good at finding ways to keep himself busy doing something and he liked it that way. He was a sharp dresser and took pride in his appearance. In fact, with the assistance of his beautician, Rachel Justice, he maintained and kept his Curl up until June of 2020 when he decided to let it go to Awldoh Gant, who became his favorite barber. He loved his Pall Mall Orange cigarettes and cruising around in his car. Even at 94 years, Artis still wanted to drive. He was a quiet man and a peacemaker and always believed in doing the right thing. He would attend St. Luke Missionary Baptist Church from time to time with his daughter, Brenda. He had his own, unconventional, ways of passing life's knowledge and wisdom on to his kids and grandkids; the lessons will never be forgotten and continue to stick in their heads to this very day. Artis loved his family and friends and would go out of his way to help them. He was just an all-around great man, husband, father, and grandfather who loved his family, dearly. Artis Spivey, Sr. is cherished and loved by many and will be greatly missed.

He is preceded in death by both of his parents and a son, Artis Spivey, Jr.
