



Clifford Carlson

October 25, 1919 - April 25, 2018

Clifford Edwin Carlson, 98, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Wednesday, April 25, 2018, at McCrite Plaza following a short illness.

Clifford was born October 25, 1919, in Clifton, Kansas, the third child of Edwin C. and Elna V. Olson Carlson. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy's Armed Guards in February 1942, serving in both the Atlantic and Pacific theaters during WWII.

Clifford married Loretta M. Greene of Brooklyn, NY on January 10, 1946, and moved to Topeka. She preceded him in death in 1992.

After military service he worked a few years for Jones Trucking of Topeka before going to Martin Tractor Caterpillar Company of Topeka in the early 1950s. Clifford retired from Martin's (now Foley's) after more than 30 years of service with a perfect driving safety record.

Survivors include his sons, Richard (Pam) Carlson, Berryton KS and Thomas (Shelly) Carlson, Lawrence KS; grandsons, Clint Carlson, Lawrence and Eric (Malia) Carlson and great-grandson, Dane, of Lawrence; granddaughters, Jaime (Alex) Wigginton, Shawnee, KS and Sarah Carlson, Whitefish, Montana. Clifford was also preceded in death by his parents and sisters, Judy Leonhart and Ruth Gay, and his brother, Roy Carlson.

Visitation will be Sunday, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614. Burial will be private.
