November 26, 1945 - April 15, 2020

Joanne Theresa Miller, 74, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Wednesday, April 15, 2020, at Midland Hospice House.

Joanne was born November 26, 1945, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Joseph Doherty and Janet Gorsuch Doherty McCloskey. She graduated from Chambersburg High School in Pennsylvania. Joanne married Ronald Miller on October 9, 1965, in Corpus Christi Catholic Church in Chambersburg; they celebrated 54 years of marriage. She was an administrative assistant. Joanne was a member of Beta Sigma Phi, American Businesswoman's Association, Professional Secretaries Inc. and Christ the King Catholic Church. She volunteered with the American Cancer Society, as the newsletter editor for the National Active and Retired Federal Employees Association (NARFE) Chapter 0002, and anywhere else she was needed. Joanne was an avid scrapbooker.

Joanne is survived by her husband, Ron Miller; son, Eric Miller; grandson, Jacob Miller; step-father, Enoch McCloskey; and half-brother, David Doherty. She was preceded in death by her mother, Janet McCloskey; father, Joseph Doherty; brother, Michael McCloskey; aunt, Pegge Tolbert; and Grandma Gorsuch.
