Lloyd Francis Deiter, 87, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Saturday, January 26, 2019.

Lloyd was born April 13, 1931, at Paxico, Kansas, the son of G. Thomas and Golda Davis Deiter. He graduated from Paxico Rural High School. Lloyd served in the United States Army from 1955 to 1957. He was employed by Gregg Tire Company and Knoll/Linweld Welding Company, retiring in 1992. He is a member of Mother Teresa of Calcutta Catholic Church.

On June 2, 1962, Lloyd married Mary H. Buser at Fidelity, Kansas. She survives.
