



## Agnes Mary (Mock) Wrenn

September 13, 1921 - November 11, 2019

Agnes Mary Wrenn, 98, went to heaven Monday, November 11, 2019. She was born at home to Charles and Elizabeth Mock on September 13, 1921, in Paxico, Kansas. She married Roy William Wrenn on November 21, 1950. He preceded her in death.

Agnes graduated from Paxico High School with a record of perfect attendance. After a year at Clark Secretarial School, she joined Hussey and Hussey Insurance. She later joined Trinity Universal Insurance as an Insurance Underwriter. She retired from Trinity after 30 years. Agnes was a member of the Insurance Women of Kansas. She was president for two years and vice-president for two years.

A kind, very giving woman, Agnes volunteered at St. Francis Hospital for 22 years with the St. Francis Auxiliary, donating 5,000 hours with bazaars and other money-making projects. Agnes helped to start the group that made "heart pillows" for open heart patients. She was also the one who started the cookie give-a-way day for the staff at St. Francis.

Agnes gave back to her community by being a faithful blood donor. She was honored by the governor for her donation of 22 gallons of blood. Toward the last of Agnes' donations, she gave platelets.

The thing her family and friends will remember most about Agnes is her rosaries! She made hundreds of rosaries which went to family, friends, charity, and for church auctions. Some made their way to the St. Francis gift shop. She did not take money for any of them.

Agnes will be greatly missed by her family. She is survived by her daughter, Sue Moore of Amarillo, Texas; daughter-in-law, Diane Wrenn of Hanna, Wyoming; granddaughters, Stephanie Wrenn of Hanna, Wyoming, and Nicole Bolte (Jake) of Casper, Wyoming; grandson, Adam Moore of Kansas City, Missouri; and great-grandsons Zarek and Lucian Bolte of Casper, Wyoming. Agnes was preceded in death by her husband, Roy; son, Steve Wrenn; grandsons, William and James Wrenn; and her parents.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, November 16, at Mater Dei Holy Name Church, 10th and Clay Street, with rosary being prayed at 10 a.m. Burial will follow in Mount Calvary Cemetery.
