



## Alan Muckenthaler

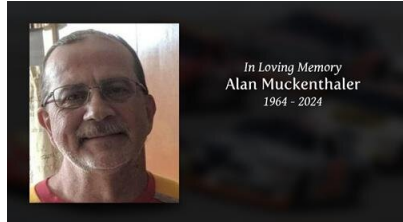

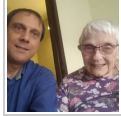
