Alexander Joseph Beuerlein, 29, Topeka, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family, Saturday, January 21, 2017, in Omaha NE, due to complications following transplant surgery.

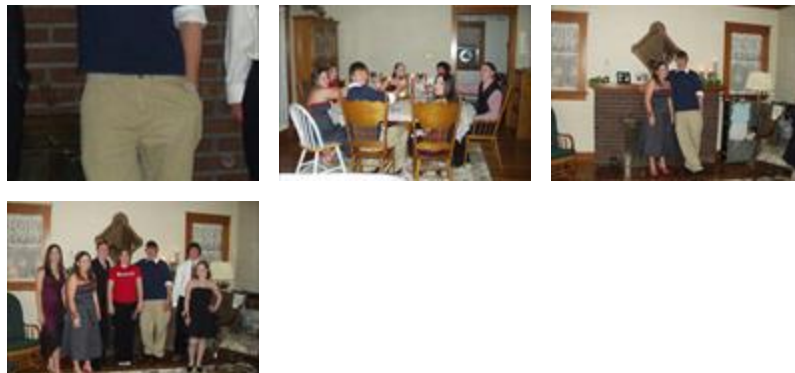
