Alexander P. Hefner, Jr., 79, Topeka, passed away Thursday, November 6, 2014. Alex was born February 24, 1935, in Topeka, the son of Alexander and Catherine Kamer Hefner. He was a 1955 graduate of Hayden High School and served our country in the US Army. He was a carman for Santa Fe Railroad until his retirement.
