Alice Louise Cameron, 83, Topeka, passed away Sunday, September 6, 2015, at her home surrounded by her loving family.

Alice was born October 20, 1931, in Seneca, Kansas, the daughter of Paul and Helen Wilson Lueb. She worked for a time as a telephone operator, which is how she met her future husband, Alan E.
