Anna Marie “Ann” Mauer Harmes, 93, passed away Saturday, November 7, 2020.

Ann was born May 1, 1927, in Topeka, Kansas, the tenth child born to John and Anna “Emma” Hefner Mauer. On October 5, 1944, Ann married Pete Harmes from Corpus Christie, Texas, at St. Joseph Church, Topeka. He preceded her in death February 7, 1972.

Ann was a member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Church, MPH Women’s Fellowship and the VFW Women’s Auxiliary. She retired from the Department of Revenue for the State of Kansas in 1989.
