Ann Cecilia Strecker, 80, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Friday, April 19, 2024. Ann was born May 16, 1943, to Paul and Elizabeth Degginger Strecker.

She was a member of the Shawnee County Historical Society since she was in high school and also the Kansas Historical Society, Kansas Preservation Alliance and National Trust.
