Anna Lee Farlow, 91, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, September 3, 2018.

Anna Lee was born April 14, 1927, in Horton, Brown County, Kansas, the daughter of August and Laura Siebenmorgen Rothmier. She attended schools in Huron and graduated from Atchison County Community High School in Effingham in 1945. Anna Lee worked as a secretary in the Kansas Social Welfare Department for several years and as a bookkeeper at a livestock sale barn for many years. She also kept books for the family cattle business.

Anna Lee and Leland D. Farlow were married at Purcell, Kansas, on March 15, 1951, enjoying almost 62 years together before his death on March 2, 2013. They were charter members of St. Matthew Catholic Church for over 30 years before moving to Maple Hill. Later they became members at Christ the King Catholic Church, Topeka.

Anna Lee was exceedingly organized, an excellent seamstress, a wonderful homemaker and enjoyed crocheting afghans, baby afghans and name plaques for family and friends. Family was most important to her.
