Anna Marie Herman, 97, Topeka, Kansas, passed away peacefully surrounded by her family, Friday, January 24, 2025.

Anna Marie was born July 11, 1927, in Topeka, the daughter of John and Rosa Desch Lambrecht. She spoke only German and learned English first in a one room schoolhouse, Kaw Valley School, and then attended St. Joseph Grade School. On November 12, 1947, Anna Marie and Sylvester George "Shorty" (or Eastie) Herman were united in marriage at St. Joseph Catholic Church. He passed away June 30, 1987.

Anna Marie was an independent, hard working woman of character. She was a fabulous cook! She loved feeding people and no one ever left hungry. On New Year's Day family and friends would descend upon her home for her fried chicken and homemade chicken noodle soup with homemade noodles. The family fished together every Sunday, which also included a fried chicken picnic meal. Ann Marie loved gardening and working outside, weed-eating into her late 80s. Even at the end of her life she was still taking care of her family.

Anna Marie loved her family! She doted on her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. They added joy to her life and she to theirs. Her presence on this earth will be greatly missed.
