Annabelle was an elementary school teacher in several Nebraska country schools. She married the late Norman Hause and they had two children. They pastored the Church of God in Billings, Montana and did missionary work at Wounded Knee, South Dakota They also pastored in Newcastle, Wyoming and Okeene, Oklahoma. Annabelle worked in the office at Luther Place in Topeka, the office of Dr. Snyder and Lane's Custom Interiors. She was a part of the foster grandparent program at Capper and KNI where she met Claude Barker. They were married for 10 years before he passed away.

Survivors include her children, Esther Lane, Berryton, and son, David Hause, Reno, Nevada; sisters, Dolly Underhill and Marie McMinn; five grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. Two brothers, Robert and Melvin Osborn, also preceded her in death.
