Arthur L. Lewerenz, 71, Topeka, passed away Sunday, May 01, 2005, after an extended illness.

Art was born February 8, 1934 in Wichita, the son of Arthur and Emma Riffel Lewerenz.

He earned a bachelor's degree from Kansas State University, a master's degree in agricultural economics from the University of Chicago, and a master's degree in business administration from Wichita State University. Arthur served his country in the US Army. He operated Lewerenz Hardware and Implement Dealerships in Marion and Lincolnvillle, taught at Wichita State University, worked for the Kansas Dept. of Social & Rehabilitation Services, and Kansas Legal Services.

He married Susan Olin. She preceded him in death. On June 28, 1975, Art and Joan Stuhlsatz were married in Topeka.

Survivors include his wife, Joan; a daughter, Sarah Knutson, and her husband, Craig, and granddaughters, Laurel Joan and Ruby True, Lawrence.
