Arthur Edward Schneider, 87, Topeka, died Sat., Mar. 25, 2006 at St. Luke's Hospital.

Art was born July 1, 1918 in Denver CO, the son of the late Arthur and Teresa Blair Schneider. He grew up in Chula MO where he graduated from Chula High. Art served in the Army Air Corps in the Pacific theater during WWII. In Oct. 1944, he and Mary Towle were married in Topeka. She preceded him in death April 22, 2003. He was a postal clerk with the US Postal Service until he retired with 30 years of service. Art was a member of Holy Name Church, and the VFW, Post 1650. He loved fishing, golf and hunting and was an avid sports fan.
