Barbara Ann Saldivar, 77, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Sunday, December 29, 2024.

Barbara was born in Topeka, on July 22, 1947, the daughter of Alan and Elizabeth "Betty" Challacombe Fouts. She graduated from Leavenworth High School in 1965, attended Clarks Business School and did some continuing education in computer science at Washburn University. Barbara married Santos "Andy" Saldivar on June 6, 1969. She did accounting work for the Kansas Department of Health and Environment from the 1970's to the early 1990's. Barbara was a home school mom and Sunday school teacher.

Barbara was the founder of Christians for Life and the Heart of America Memorial Wall for The Unborn.

Barbara was a lobbyist for Kansans for Life, director of Concerned Women for

America in Kansas, and she volunteered at Selah House in Lawrence. She had a great love for mothers and infants and wanted to do everything in her power to give them a good start together. Barbara enjoyed going to church every Sunday, gardening, visiting with her grandchildren, cooking, had a gift for organizing people, and had a memorable smile.

Barbara is survived by her husband; children, Kathleen Waters (George W.) and Kenneth A. Saldivar (Randi); grandchildren, George Nathaniel Waters and Elizabeth Saldivar; and sister, Aleen Halbett (Daniel). She was preceded in death by her parents and her brother, John Fouts.
