



## Bernard "Bernie" Hayden

April 17, 1923 - May 13, 2004

Bernard "Bernie" Hayden, 81, Topeka, died Thursday evening, May 13, 2004, at Midland Hospice House.

He was born April 17, 1923 in Girard, KS, the son of William and Mary Hayden.

Mr. Hayden served in the U.S. Navy during World War II; then worked for Southwestern Bell for 37 years, retiring in 1984.
