Beverly A. Gomez, 78, of Topeka, formerly of Duluth MN, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 7, 2014, with her family at her side. Beverly was born July 11, 1936, in Duluth, the daughter of Elmer and Violet (Anderson) Hagadorn. She grew up in Duluth and graduated from Denfield High School. She was married to Pete Gomez in 1956 and 19 years later they divorced. She and Pete moved to Topeka in 1959 and continued raising their family together.
