Bryan Allen Pape, 51, Denver, Colorado, passed away Thursday, April 20, 2023.

Bryan was born March 26, 1972, in Boulder, Colorado, the son of Mary Lou Gish and Larry Pape. Bryan grew up in Colorado and graduated from Smokey Hill High School in Aurora, Colorado in 1990.

Bryan was an independent software developer and electronics products designer. He also was an IT director for Boot Barn in Los Angeles, and music synthesizer designer for Ensoniq synthesizer company in Philadelphia. Bryan was also part of the design team of an innovative startup company in Sydney, Australia founded by Peter Vogel, who invented the famous Fairlight music synthesizer.

Bryan loved music and was in a band in Los Angeles called The Faded, which performed at the famed Whiskey a Go Go club on Sunset Strip in LA. The Faded was named the Best Alternative Band in Los Angeles in 2006.

He is best remembered as a kind, gentle and generous person. He will be greatly missed.

Bryan is survived by his parents Mary Lou and Larry Pape; his sister Erin;

niece Madison; and nephew Maxwell; his grandmother Ora Lee Gish; and many aunts, uncles and cousins.
