



## Calvin Patrick Rafferty

July 31, 1924 - February 20, 2017

Calvin Patrick Rafferty, 92, Topeka, passed away February 20, 2017, at Aldersgate Village.

Calvin was born July 31, 1924, in Topeka, Kansas, one of seven children of Vincent and Helen Brock Rafferty. Calvin graduated from Dover High School in 1942, and attended Washburn University. Calvin served in the United States Navy as a Seaman First Class. Calvin married Virginia C. Morrison in Yates Center, Kansas. Calvin retired from his mail carrier position in 1978. After retirement, Calvin worked for the Menninger Foundation doing medication delivery and the shuttle bus.
