Carl R. Cornell, 71, Rossville, died September 1, 2013. Carl was born November 17, 1939 to Carl A. and Violet Cornell in Marion County, Indiana. He was a Marine from 1959 to 1963 and then went into the Navy as a Seabee from 1976 to 1980. Carl was married in 1965 to Anne White Cornell and then later divorced. After the military he was a volunteer for the Marine League Corp in Indiana. He worked for GM for twenty-one years, upon retirement from GM he moved to Europe to enjoy his retirement. After Europe, he did some over the road truck driving. Carl retired from truck driving and moved to Florida for a few years before making the final move to Kansas to live out the remainder of his years.
