Carl D. Seal, 87, Lawrence, formerly of Topeka, passed away surrounded by his family on January 7, 2017.

Carl was born January 11, 1929, to Clarence and Leatha Coursey Seal in Topeka, Kansas, where he grew up and spent his entire life. He married Margaret Renyer on April 17, 1948. Carl joined the United States Navy during the last months of WWII. After service, he worked as a firefighter for the Topeka Fire Department for 35 years, from which he retired in 1983, as a Battalion Chief. Carl was an avid outdoorsman, fisherman, racing enthusiast, hunter and enjoyed camping with his family. Carl and Margaret traveled all the lower 48 states, in addition to Alaska and Canada, in their motorhome. After retiring, they spent many winters in Florida, where he enjoyed golfing and playing cards with friends.

Carl is survived by his loving wife of 68 years and best friend, Margaret; their children, Claire Rice (Eric) of Lawrence, Thom Seal (Jette) of Reno, Nevada, Diane Carlisle (Greg) of Sweet, Idaho, Jim Seal (Ruth) of Boise, Idaho, and Karla Guerrero (Ray) of Tecumseh; nine grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; and sister, Lou Moore of Chipley, Florida. He was preceded in death by his parents, and his son, Tim Seal.
