Carol Elaine Basgall, 91, Topeka, passed away April 3, 2007 at Stormont Vail Regional Medical Center. She was born in Parkersburg, Iowa April 5, 1915 the daughter of Richard A. and Lela Yost Ludeman. She graduated from Mason City, Iowa, High School in 1933, she attended North Iowa Area Community College and the University of Northern Iowa. She taught at Portland Township School No. 2. She worked at Merkels, Damons, and Younkens stores and was assistant director for Charlie Brown Community Day Care Center in Mason City, Iowa. She was a 4-H leader and Den Scout mother.
