Carol Ruth Haslouer, 79, Topeka, Kansas, beloved mother, passed away Thursday, September 18, 2025.

Carol was born May 2, 1946, in Topeka, the daughter of the late Clement William “Bill” Hochard and Ruth Virginia Jager Hochard. She graduated from Hayden High School in 1964. As a student she volunteered at the hospital as a “candy striper” and was an officer in the Future Nurses Club at Hayden. Carol attended St. Margaret School of Nursing in Kansas City and earned her LPN from Kaw Area Vocational and Technical School. She worked for Dr. Michael Giessel at Cotton-O’Neil Clinic for 23 years before retiring.

On June 24, 1994, Carol married Paul Edward Pendergast who died April 9, 1996.

Stephen George Haslouer and Carol were united in marriage on April 17, 1998, enjoying almost 17 years together before his death on March 12, 2015.

Carol loved her home in Tulsa, nature and working in her garden beds, watching and feeding the birds, relaxing at home, the KC Chiefs, craft fairs, making her famous peppernut cookies, holidays and loving and caring for those around her. Carol embraced her Catholic faith and loved her family dearly. She loved being “Gram” and cherished the time she spent with her

grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Carol was greatly loved and her presence will be sadly missed.
