Carol Lynn Larson Quast, 73, Topeka, passed away Saturday, December 21, 2013. Carol was born May 7, 1940, in Saginaw MI, the daughter of Harlan and Rachel Robinson Larson. She earned a degree in music from the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor and her master's degree in cello performance from Drake University. Carol was forever a selfless mother and grandmother. She retired from the state of North Carolina where she taught orchestra predominantly kindergarten through 12th grades but also at Miliken University. Carol was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. On June 28, 1972, Carol and Theodore Quast were united in marriage. He survives. Other survivors include her children, Ted E. Quast III (Monica) Topeka, Linnea Ockey (Mark) Topeka, Paul L. Quast (Tiffany) Midland MI, and Arthur D.
