Charles Eugene Beall, Sr., 89, Topeka KS, passed away Saturday, December 21, 2024.

Charles was born in Leavenworth, Kansas, on October 16, 1935, the son of Thomas and Antoinette “Nettie” Kurek Beall. He graduated from Leavenworth High School and earned degrees from Kansas University and Kansas State University. Charles served in the United States Army and the Kansas National Guard. He married Ida Viola Quisenberry in 1954; they celebrated 70 years together this year.
