Charles Michael Hane, 68, Topeka, passed away Sunday, August 4, 2024. He was born December 3, 1955, in Topeka, the son of Arthur and Henrietta Heaney Hane.

Charlie attended Holy Name Grade School, graduated from Hayden High School and Washburn University. He enjoyed reading, particularly military history and science fiction. He served in the United States Army, achieving the rank of Captain. His service had a profound impact on his life and view of the world. After retiring from more than 30 years of managing the receiving dock at St. Francis Hospital, Charlie volunteered with Helping Hands Humane Society, where he adopted his beloved Maddie dog. He spent the final years of his life enjoying his backyard garden with Maddie and feeding the neighborhood birds and squirrels. Charlie was a musician his entire life and played guitar and sang in numerous bands, often with his best friend and baby brother, Steve. He will be remembered as a caring, interesting, and unique individual with a strong sense of self.

He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers, Jim, Jeff, and Steve Hane, and sister-in-law, Mary Hane. Charlie is survived by his daughters, Erika Fincham (Ethan) of Lawrence and Emily Hane (Chris Overfelt) of Kansas City; grandsons, James Robert Fincham and Edgar Arthur Fincham; sisters Kathy Hurla (David) and Terri Cooper of Topeka; sister-in-law Amy Hane of Topeka;
