



## Charles Musick

January 19, 1926 - August 12, 2012

Charles David Musick, 86, Topeka, died on Sunday, Aug. 12, 2012, at the VA Hospital due to complications of pneumonia and Alzheimer's disease.

Charles was born in Topeka to James E. Musick and Lena Harris Musick on Jan. 19, 1926, the youngest of eight children. While in Junior High and Topeka High School he excelled in sports; track, football and basketball. He spent his entire life in Topeka except when he served in the Marine Corp in WWII. He was wounded at Ie Shima and received the Purple Heart. His Marine unit was marched across destroyed Hiroshima in Japan at war's end. He spent his working years at Southwestern Bell (ATT). In younger years, he was an avid bowler and water skier, often owning a boat. His memberships included the Masonic Lodge 90, Arab Shrine, VFW 1650, American Legion 1 and Bell Telephone Pioneers.

Charles married Margaret M. Thoms Musick in 1947 and they had 65 wonderful years together. Other survivors include his daughter, Linda J. Kyser and husband, Ardell; granddaughters, Kristin Ingwerson and husband, Gene, Megan Norris and husband, David; five great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews; and his pal, Sadie, a Black Lab. Preceding him in death were his parents in 1958 and 1961, and siblings, Barbara Krentz in 1995; Jack Musick in 2002; Helen Brown in 1994; Clifford Musick in 2006; Lois Harris in 1996; Elmer (Bud) Musick in 1982; and Bernice Brown in 1977.
