



Charles Sayler

December 19, 1924 - January 2, 2015

Charles Keith Sayler, 90, Topeka, passed away December 29, 2014, at McCrite Plaza. Mr. Sayler was born December 19, 1924, to John and Inez Sayler in Topeka KS. He was a graduate of Topeka High School, the University of New Mexico, the one-year program of Harvard Business School for Midshipmen and Officers and the Washburn Law School. He served his country during World War II as a naval officer and remained in the Naval Reserves until 1955, leaving with the rank of lieutenant. Keith married the love of his life, Lois Sholander Dawson, on February 7, 1951. She died on November 7, 2009. An infant son, Miles Keith Sayler, died in 1955. Mr. Sayler is survived by several nieces and nephews. A member of the bar in Kansas and Oklahoma, Mr. Sayler was one of the founding members of the law firm of Fisher Patterson, Sayler, and Smith in Topeka. He served on the Federal Judge Selection Commission for Kansas and was a frequent lecturer at Kansas Bar Association seminars on workman's compensation, his area of expertise. The Saylers were members of Shawnee Country Club for many years where they indulged their passion for golf and Mr. Sayler served on the Board of Directors. He was a long time member of First Presbyterian Church. Graveside services will be at 11:00 a.m. Friday at Penwell-Gabel Cemetery.
