Charles Francis Schneider, 63, of Topeka, passed away peacefully at Veterans Hospital on Thursday, November 28, 2013. Charles was born in Salina KS, one of nine children, to Charles and Christina (Schieffer) Schneider. He went to Sacred Heart school in Salina and to Kansas State University where he received his B.S. degree. Charles served in the Marine Corps from 1968-1971 during the Vietnam War.
