Chett Thomas Behner, 41, Lawrence, formerly of Topeka, passed away Friday, August 12, 2016, at his home. He was born December 2, 1974, in Kansas City MO, the youngest child of Thomas and Marsa Adams Behner.

Chett graduated from Washburn Rural High School in 1993, where he excelled as a runner in track. He worked in warehouse and service industries. In 2007, he earned an Associate of Applied Business Degree from the Golf Academy of Arizona in Phoenix. He was extremely knowledgeable and passionate about music, loved playing golf, and cherished time with his nieces and nephews, who meant so much to him. He volunteered at food kitchens wanting to help others. One of Chett's greatest attributes was his terrific sense of humor. He had a caring heart, was a loyal friend and always acknowledged the kindness of anyone who helped him. His death is a tremendous loss and he is now at peace.

He leaves to treasure his memory, mother, Marsa Behner, Lawrence; sisters, Carrie Rezac (David), Olathe, and Sherrie Mann (Chris), Overland Park; and five nieces and nephews. His father preceded him in death on November 15, 2015.

Visitation will take place from 10 to 11 a.m. Friday at Christ the King Catholic Church, 5973 SW 25th Street, Topeka KS 66614. Mass of Resurrection will be

celebrated at 11 a.m. Cremation will follow and inurnment will take place at a later date at Mount Calvary Cemetery, Topeka.

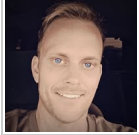

U know, I think we ALL have the biggest fear in life is not being remembered. To just be some drop in a bucket. Chett will NEVER have to worry about that. With all the stories and good times I share with my new wife and 2 children I know at least for me, that his candle will always remain lit.

I hope someone reads this and it helps them in SOME way today. I know Chett would like that. He always wanted everyone to be together. Everyone to talk. Everyone to put down their walls and just be themselves. Chett. I love you. I love you and I miss you so much. Just before u had passed, we had planned a trip for u to come and visit me. Sometimes I wonder if u knew just HOW HAPPY I was to

know that u still cared enough about our friendship that u would come all the way out to Arizona to come stay with me. It meant so much. I was so excited. And I really needed u at that time in my life. But then I found out that u were gone. What a shock. What a loss. It makes me so sad....

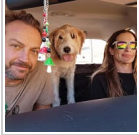
