January 1, 1753 - July 17, 2007

Clara K. Asbury, 62, Topeka KS passed away on Sat. July 14, after a long fight with cancer. She was born Aug. 23, 1945 on the family farm in Wamego KS. Clara was the daughter of Bill and Evelyn Doll. She attended St. Bernard's Elementary School in Wamego and Lucky Catholic High School in Manhattan. She graduated from Washburn University with an English Degree. She received her Masters in Social Work in 1994. Clara married Thomas Kent Asbury on Oct. 14, 1967, at St. Bernard's church in Wamego. He passed away on Sept. 12, 2004.
