Claude Wilson Reynolds, 91, Topeka, died Wednesday, March 24, 2004 at Midland Hopsice. He was born in Severy, KS to Burton Jackson & Malinda Yoachim Reynolds. Mr. Reynolds graduated from Mulvane High School in 1931 and attended Friends University in Wichita, KS. He graduated from the Kansas State Teachers College of Pittsburg in 1937 with a Bachelor of Science in Education degree and was a 2- sport letterman in football and track. In 1960 he earned a Masters of Science degree from the Kansas State Teachers College of Emporia. On June 4, 1939 in Mulvane, he married Irene Ruth Howard, she survives. He was a teacher and coach at Waterville, Mulvane, Wamego, Highland Park and Shawnee Heights High Schools. He was a member of the Highland Park United Methodist Church and the Pittsburg State University Alumni Association. He was preceded in death by a brother, Lowell "Lank" Reynolds in 1990 and a granddaughter, Rebecca Reynolds in 2002. He is survived by his sons; Michael Claude Reynolds and wife Susan, Russell Lowell Reynolds, Douglas Howard Reynolds and wife Linda, all of Topeka; granddaughters Kristi Reynolds, Melissa Flesher and husband Ryan, Allison Reynolds, Malinda Reynolds, Heidi Garren, Lisa Garren, grandson, Matthew Garren and two nephews and one niece. Mr. Reynolds will lie in state from 3 to 7pm, Sunday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Rd., Topeka, KS 66614 with family visitation from 5 to 7pm. Funeral service will be held 11:00 am, Monday, March 29, 2004, at Highland Park United Methodist Church with the casket open one

hour prior. Burial will be at Mount Hope Cemetery.
