



Cletus Simons

May 10, 1924 - December 18, 2016

Cletus Nicholas Simons, 92, Topeka, passed away Sunday, December 18, 2016.

Clete was born May 10, 1924, in Alexandria, South Dakota, the son of Thomas and Josephine Kies Simons. He served our country in the US Army as a paratrooper in the 82nd Airborne Division during WWII. Clete was wounded in the Battle of the Bulge and returned to the front line after a short time of healing. He received the Purple Heart as well as many other decorations. In 2013, Clete was awarded the French Legion of Honor medal, authorized by the President of France, for his efforts to liberate France.

On January 25, 1951, Clete Simons and Carmen Reynoso were united in marriage. He was an Iron Worker and member of Local 10. They moved several times to different parts of the country before settling in Topeka in 1957. He retired after 48 years of service in that profession. They enjoyed almost 65 years of marriage.

He was a member of Mater Dei Holy Name Church. Clete was a great brother, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather and friend.

Grateful to have shared his life are his wife, Carmen; their children, Gary Simons, Joseph Simons (Jan), Pat Simons (Sharon), Carol Main (Frank) and

Tim Simons (Beth); 10 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren and 1 great-great-grandchild; and many nieces and nephews. Clete was preceded in death by his parents and all his siblings; Hazel, Don, Mike, Bob, Dorothy, Joanne, Bill, Monica, Tom, Everett and Arlene.

Funeral service will be at 11 a.m. Friday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614, where family will greet friends one hour prior to service.
