April 28, 1915 - September 12, 2007

Clifford L. Chappell, 92, died September 12, 2007 at Topeka Presbyterian Manor. He was born April 28, 1915, the son of Thomas E. Chappell and Jennie Grieve Chappell. He attended Topeka Public Schools and graduated from Topeka High School in 1933. He served in the U.S Army Air Corps in World War II from 1942 to 1945. After discharge he attended College of Advanced Traffic in Chicago, IL. He was employed by ATSF Railroad for 36 years and retired in 1977. Mr. Chappell was a 63 year member of Capitol Post No. 1 of The American Legion. He served as Post Commander from 1982-1983 and was Finance Officer for 15 years. He volunteered at the V.A. Hospital for 24 years. He was a member of V.A. Voluntary Services advisory committee for 15 years representing the State American Legion. In 1971 he received the Service to Mankind Award from the Topeka Evening Sertoma Club. Also in 1971 he was presented the Service to Mankind Award by the North Kansas District of Sertoma International. Clifford and Patricia Moore were married on August 29, 1953 in Topeka. She survives him. He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother and sister, Hartley E. Chappell and Marguerite Rice. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Topeka. No service is planned. Cremation and burial will take place at Mount Hope Cemetery.
