Cloudia "Allen" Calhoun, 94, passed from this earth Monday, September 16, 2024, in Topeka, Kansas. He was born July 12, 1930, to Edwin and Louisa Calhoun in Roston, Arkansas.

Allen graduated from Lanesburg High School. He then joined the United States Airforce from which he retired from after 20 years of service. After the Airforce, he worked for Goodyear and retired from there after 24 years. He held a few jobs afterwards such as working for Campers on Mission and rehabilitated churches where it was needed.

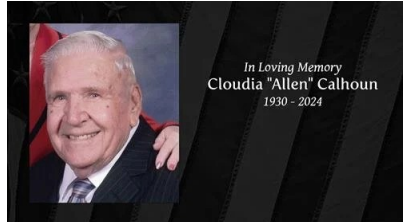
