Courtney Kathleen Biesemeyer, 33, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on February 21, 2020. She was born to Stephen and Lisa (Clayburg) Lincoln in Topeka on July 19, 1986. Courtney graduated from Washburn Rural in 2004, attended Washburn University for two years, and worked for Topeka OB-GYN at University of Kansas-St. Francis Campus.

Courtney was a sassy, independent, selfless, outspoken helper who made a lasting impact on those who had the pleasure of knowing her. She was the best mom to Cameron and Avery and enjoyed being involved in their activities, school functions, and sports, where she was their #1 cheerleader. Courtney was loved by her coworkers in labor and delivery, and was known for telling patients, “You got this, girl” when the going got tough.

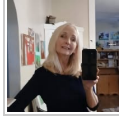
