Cynthia (Cindy) Ann Scott July 6, 1957 – October 24, 2011 After a courageous eight year battle with cancer, Cindy passed away peacefully at her home in Topeka, KS. Cindy was born and raised in Topeka, attended Holy Name Grade School, and graduated from Hayden High School in 1975. After working for Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, she stayed home to raise her three children, and returned to work for the last fifteen years at Martinek & Flynn Wholesale. Cindy was one of six children born to Clarence and Betty Martinek and the beloved wife of Glen Scott for 34 years.
