Dale "Pink" Romine, 87, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at The House at Midland Care with his family at his side. He was born on November 21, 1931, in Burlingame, Kansas, son of Clair and Mable Romine, and graduated from Harveyville High School.
