



Dallas Richards

January 3, 1935 - January 16, 2025

Due to anticipated severe winter weather, Dallas' Celebration of Life has been rescheduled to 1 p.m. Monday, February 24, 2025.

Dallas L. Richards passed away peacefully at Midland Care Hospice in Topeka, Kansas on January 16, 2025, at the age of 90 following a long battle with COPD.

Dallas was born on January 3, 1935, in the rural community of Tecumseh, Kansas. His parents, Earl and Ruth Richards, preceded him in death, as well as his wife, Cacilie, who passed in 2013, and his brother, George Richards, who passed in 2012.

Dallas is survived by his brother Roger Richards and his wife, Leigh; George's wife, Sharon Richards; six nieces and nephews and several grand-nieces and grand-nephews.

Dallas attended Tecumseh Elementary School and Topeka's Highland Park High School. He joined the U S Army in 1953 and was honorably discharged in 1973. He was stationed in several countries over his period of service including Germany where he met and married his wife, Cacile. They eventually settled in Junction City, Kansas. Dallas and Cacilie developed many close friends there keeping in touch with several of them after his move

to Topeka.

In the fall of 2017, Dallas suffered some serious health issues which required him to relocate to Topeka for specialized medical treatment. After several months of hospitalization, in April 2018, he had recovered enough to be able to move into independent living at Brewster Place Retirement Community. He lived an active life at Brewster until late 2024 when his COPD worsened.
