Daniel Joseph Vargas, 57, Topeka, passed away Tuesday, October 4, 2005. Dan was born July 17, 1948 in Topeka to Manuel Vargas, Sr. and Emily Terrones Vargas. Dan attended the University of Kansas earning a Bachelor in Fine Arts degree in Interior Design. He was an interior designer and President of Vargas Fine Furniture, Inc. He also worked for Discovery Furniture. He served in the Army during the Vietnam War, earning an Army Commendation Medal. Dan was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church where he was involved in many ministries and volunteer activities. Dan served as a Grand Knight for the CTK Knights of Columbus Council #8411. At weekend masses, Dan served as a Eucharistic Minister, Lector, and Usher. He also participated in Perpetual Adoration and was a member of the Parish Council. His involvement with the youth of the parish included teaching Religious Education Classes and assisting with Altar Server Training. Dan was a member of the International Society of Interior Design, listed many times in the Who's Who of interior design, and took part in the Every Woman's Resource Center Designer Showhouses. In 1983 he won the Outstanding Man of America award. Survivors include his mother, Emily Terrones Vargas, Topeka; brothers, Manuel Vargas, Jr. and John Vargas both of Topeka, nephew, Chris Vargas, Topeka; niece, Maura Vargas, Topeka; Aunt, Beatrice Waters, Topeka. He was preceded in death by his father.
