



## Danny W. Huske

August 3, 1946 - March 6, 2009

Danny Wayne Huske, 62, of Silver Lake, passed away Tues. March 3, 2009 at Midland Hospice House. He was born August 3, 1946, the son of the late Irvin B. Huske, Jr. and Harriet "Terry" Perry. Dan grew up in the Silver Lake area and graduated from Silver Lake High School in 1964. He attended Washburn University briefly before going to work for Western Electric in 1965. Dan enlisted in the Navy in 1967 and was stationed aboard a destroyer before receiving his honorable discharge in 1971. He returned to work for Western Electric, which became ATT then Lucent Technologies, retiring in 2002. He then went to work for USD 372 Silver Lake, retiring in 2008 due to health concerns. Dan was a member of American Legion Post 160. He was an avid golfer and was fond of KSU Football and any Silver Lake sports. He was also a great supporter of American Legion baseball. Dan married Nancy K. McVay in 1976 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church. She survives. He was preceded in death by his father and a sister, Barbara Fulton. Other survivors include three children; Danelle Boone (Rodney) of Olathe, Ryan Huske (Kendell) of Overland Park and Kaylene Huske of Silver Lake; his mother, Terri Perry (Dick) of Topeka and two sisters, Bev Lindstrom (Johnny) and Debbie Thompson (Jim), all of Silver Lake and numerous nieces and nephews. Dan will lie in state at 5:00 pm, Fri. March 6, 2009 at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW. Urish Rd, Topeka, KS 66614, where the family will receive friends from 5:00 to 7:30pm. A parish rosary will be prayed at 5:30. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 am, Sat. March 7 at
