Darell Lee Mitchell, 81, Topeka, passed away Thursday, July 23, 2015, at the House at Midland Care.

Darell was born June 24, 1934, in Lawrence, Kansas, the son of Allen and Pauline Osborn Mitchell. He graduated from Topeka High School in 1952 and married his high school sweetheart, Mary Ann Borsdorf, on December 30, 1953. She preceded him in death on June 29, 2005.

Darell served our country in the Army Reserves. His career with the Topeka Fire Department spanned 36 years and he retired as a District Chief in 1991. He was a long-time resident of Lake Wabaunsee.
