Darrel Lee Brake, 74, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Tuesday, April 16, 2024.

Darrel was born January 26, 1950, in Hamburg, Iowa, the son of Deward and Betty Cavner Brake. He graduated from Atlantic High School and earned an associate degree from Marshalltown Community College. He served our country in the US Air Force where he received his education to become a computer programmer.

In his early years, sports played an important part in Darrel's life. He continued that passion through coaching his sons' sports and then became his grandchildren's biggest "sports advisor" and fan. In addition, he cheered on KU basketball, KC Chiefs, the Royals, and golf became his full-time retirement hobby.

Darrel retired in 2009 after 35 years with Blue Cross Blue Shield, as Director of Information Systems Application Development.

A special memory the grandkids have is of him performing magic tricks to delight them. He was a calm and not easily rattled person. He liked to coach, listen to, mentor and care for others. He was very proud of his sons and his grandchildren were very special to him. He cared deeply and was dearly loved. He will be missed.
