Deane E. Kohn, 83, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Tuesday, July 2, 2019, at The House at Midland Care Hospice.

Deane was born June 1, 1936, in Dover, Kansas, the son of Henry and Nina Campbell Kohn. He graduated from Maple Hill High School in 1954.
