Debie Desch Bechtold Lueke, 63, formerly of Topeka, passed away February 26, 2018, in Green Valley, Arizona, after a return of lymphoma.

She was born on October 28, 1954, in Oakland, California to John and Joyce Desch, moved to Topeka as a child and remained in Topeka until 2009 when she moved to Arizona. Debie graduated from Hayden High School and Stormont-Vail School of Nursing. She earned a master's degree as a Nurse Practitioner at KU.

Debie worked as a nurse at Topeka State Hospital, and Menningers in Topeka. After moving to Arizona she was employed as a nurse manager at Tucson Medical Center, was a professor at Northern Arizona University and most recently worked as Director of Nursing at Crisis Response Network of Southern Arizona.

Debie's hobbies included knitting, music, beading and she loved KU basketball. She also loved animals of all kinds and the desert.

She is preceded in death by her mother, Joyce Desch, and brother, Greg Desch.
