Dennis Duane Scott, 64, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Monday, May 18, 2020.

Dennis was born March 13, 1956, in Topeka, the son of James “Jim” and Henrietta “Hap” Keating Scott. He attended Kansas School for the Deaf in Olathe, Kansas, and NTID in Rochester, New York. Dennis had been employed at Hallmark and Packerware. He was active in the deaf community and a member of the Deaf Club. Dennis enjoyed playing cards with his family. Dennis is survived by his mother, Hap; sisters, Diane Gehrt (Pete), Julie Spangler (Mike), Kim Scott and Jean Scott (Stan Swartz); numerous aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father, Jim.
