



Diedre "Dede" Blick

June 26, 1932 - June 12, 2006

Diedre (Dede) R. Blick, age 73, of Topeka died Tuesday, June 12, 2006 at her home.. She was born June 26, 1932, in Louisville, Kentucky, the daughter of Clinton Flynn and Eva Irene (Miller) Flynn Burnett. She was raised in Hutchinson, Kansas and graduated from Hutchinson High School in 1950. Dede was a homemaker. She married Maurus N. Blick on July 20, 1951, in Warrensburg, Missouri. The Blick family and approximately 100 families moved from Hutchinson to Topeka in 1967 with what is now the 190th Air Refueling Wing. Her husband Maurus, survives of the home. Other survivors include four sons, Maurus C. and his wife Brenda, Robert and his wife Becky, and Daniel, all of Topeka, William of Hutchinson; one daughter, Lanaea Heine and her husband Rodney of Lawrence; 9 grandchildren; her sister, LeAnna Morse of McAllen, Teaxas; and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother Robert C. Flynn. She was one of the founding members of PACK, a social organization for members and former-members of the 190th Air Refueling Wing of the Kansas Air National Guard. She was an avid artists and crafts maker. She had a passion for family geneology and had written a book about the Blick family. She enjoyed spending time with her children, grandchildren, and nieces and nephews. Visitation will be from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Wed, June 14 at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home.
