Dolores M Tangari age 78 died Thursday September 24 2009. Mrs. Tangari was born August 5, 1931 in St. Paul Minnesota, the daughter of Andrew and Marie Hanacek Doyle and was raised in White Bear Lake, Minnesota. She was a graduate of White Bear Lake High School and earned a Diploma in Nursing from the University of St. Catherine's in St. Paul, Minnesota and a BSW from Washburn University, Topeka, Kansas. She served as an Officer in the US Air Force where she met her future husband Anthony Tangari. They were married on August 11, 1956, he preceded her in death in 2008. Mrs. Tangari was employed as a registered nurse at the Shawnee County Health Department for 9 years and eventually retired from the Menninger Foundation.
